

GROUP CHECK-IN (20 mins):

Take a few minutes to catch up and see how everyone is doing.

- “How was your week? What was the high point? What was the low point?”

QUICK RECAP

We are going to end by both looking back and looking forward. So far we’ve begun to create margin in our lives (*Make room*), started investing in relationships (*Close the Gap*), seen that our story can help others (*Look for the overlap*), and seen how easy it can be to discover and apply the Scriptures (*Know the Word, Do the Word*). 3. What would it look like for you to take a step from “preparing” to “doing”? Who comes to mind as someone you could begin walking with spiritually?



READ

Matthew 28:19-20 - The Great Commission

PRAYER (5 mins):

Choose one or more people to pray for the group members: (Here are some prompts to help if you are having trouble getting started):

- "God, thank you for giving us purpose, for calling us to be a part of your mission."
- "Give each of us the courage to step out and begin a disciple making relationship."
- "Work through us to bring many people into a relationship with you."

CELEBRATE:

Now that you have finished up all of the trainings, take a few minutes to share any "wins" that you have had over the past 10 weeks. Here are a few questions to help guide your thoughts:

- How have you seen God bless you as you have made room in your calendar for disciple-making?
- Have you seen any shifts in any relationships as you have begun to pray for the lost each week?
- Are there any stories that you have gotten to share with anyone?
- What have you been putting into practice in your life as you have begun to read Scripture?



ACCOUNTABILITY

If we don't continue to put these things into practice in our lives, we will likely never see God use us to reach the lost people around us. Discuss the following question: What is our action plan moving forward to keep disciple-making a priority in our lives?
